FOREWORD

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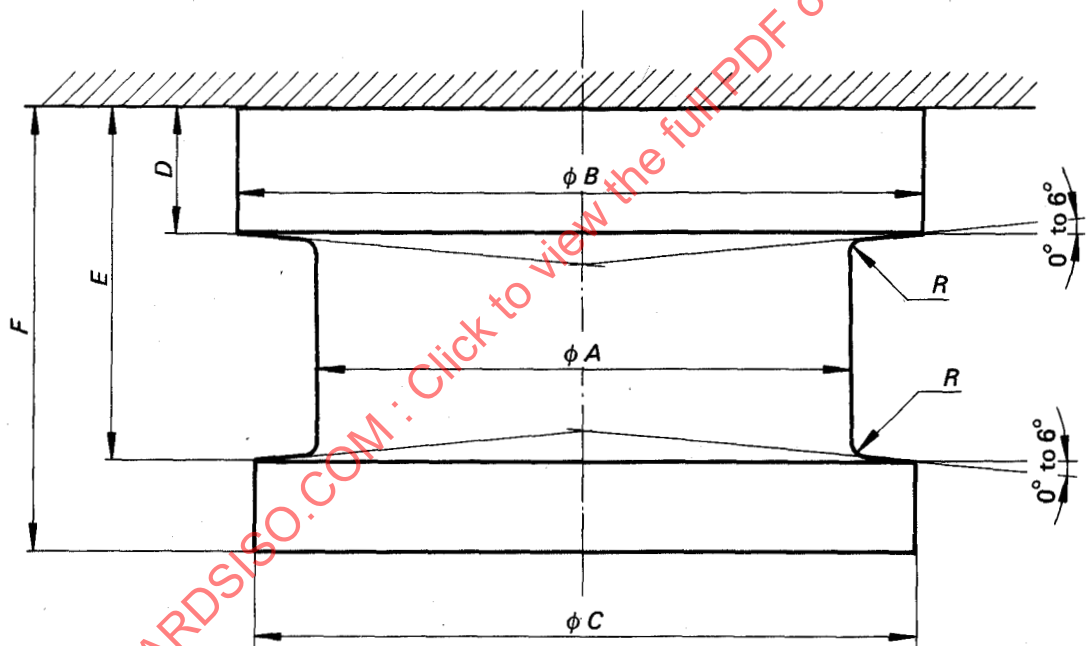
Road vehicles — 90 Semi-trailer fifth wheel coupling pin — Dimensions

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard specifies the dimensions of the 90 [ϕ 89 mm (3.5 in)] fifth wheel coupling pin which is used for coupling extra-heavy-duty vehicles exceeding the limitations of weight generally laid down by official requirements.

NOTE — The 50 semi-trailer fifth wheel coupling pin is the subject of ISO 337.
